

Brackett & Ellis, P.C. Notifies Clients of Security Incident

Brackett & Ellis, P.C. (“Brackett & Ellis”) values the relationship we have with our clients and understands the importance of protecting their personal information. This notice relates to a security incident that may have involved some of our clients’ personal information.

Brackett & Ellis recently concluded our investigation of a security incident that involved unauthorized access to two employees’ email accounts. Upon learning of the unauthorized access, we secured the two employees’ email accounts and launched an investigation of the incident with the assistance of a leading third-party forensic firm. Through our investigation of the incident, Brackett & Ellis determined that an unauthorized party may have accessed emails and attachments sent to the employees’ email accounts which contained some of our clients’ personal information, such as client names, dates of birth, addresses, Social Security numbers, and medical information.

Although, to date, Brackett & Ellis has no evidence that any personal information has been misused, out of an abundance of caution, we are publishing this notice on our website. Brackett & Ellis encourages our clients to actively monitor for the possibility of fraud and identity theft by reviewing your credit report and credit card, bank, and other financial statements for any unauthorized activity.

Brackett & Ellis sincerely regrets any concern this may cause you. To help prevent this from happening in the future, we have implemented additional safeguards and technical security measures.
